Accommodation

Players will stay in a hotel to be determined. The hotel will be in the Northern Virginia area, within close proximity to the tournament site.

Meals

Friday: Players will eat dinner while traveling to VA. Players will be responsible for the cost of this.

Saturday: All meals to be provided to players. Included in cost of tour.

Sunday: Breakfast and lunch to be provided to players and included in cost of tour. Players will eat dinner while traveling home to Narberth. Players are responsible for cost of dinner.

Cost

The cost to each player will be \$150.00. This will include hotel rooms, meals as outlined above, transportation to/from the tournament, and transportation. If a player is experiencing financial hardship please contact Coach DeLuca. All players are expected to go on tour.

Medication

Players should make certain to bring any medications they may need and should provide coaches with important information regarding the medications (please see Parent Permission Form). Players will not be allowed to take any medications that are not listed on the Parent Permission Form.

FAQ

- Q1. How will the team be traveling?
- A1. The team will depart from Narberth RFC on Friday, April 20th at 3:30pm via two (2) Rental Passenger Vans. Each van holds a 12 person capacity and will be driven by coaches.
- Q2. Why Leesburg, VA?
- A2. Washington International Rugby Festival; Rugby, rugby, rugby; featuring teams from Canada and the U.S.!
- Q3. Is there a dress code for the tour?
- A3. Yes, the players will be required to travel to & from Narberth, PA to Leesburg, VA in khaki pants and navy blue polo shirt.
- Q4. What happens if my rugby player gets injured while on tour?
- A4. First and foremost we will do everything within our power to ensure that the players are kept safe throughout the tour. As with any match, the potential for injury exists. Tournament hosts will have medical staff at the matches and will provide Narberth RFC with an emergency action plan in order to provide the necessary emergency care. It is important that you provide the coaches with the requested insurance information in order to expedite this care.
- Q5. Who will be supervising my rugby player while on tour?
- A5. Coaches will be traveling with the team in order to provide appropriate supervision during matches and activities. Players will be closely monitored and supervised during "free time". With this being said, it is the responsibility of your rugby player to make positive choices while on tour.
- *Q6.* Who is financing the tour and what is the cost?
- A6. Each player will be responsible for paying \$150.00 to travel on tour. Each player will be responsible for their own "miscellaneous" spending money.
- *Q7.* Are families allowed to join the tour?
- A7. We are welcoming families (supporters as they are called in the rugby community) to travel along side the team during the tour. With this being said, it will be the responsibility of the supporters to organize all transportation, accommodation, and meals. Coach DeLuca will provide parents with a finalized itinerary to assist them in organizing their trip. Please remember that your rugby player will be on tour, and no player will be allowed to leave the team tour in order to attend a family scheduled event. (See Attached Itinerary)
